DuPage Swim Center Group Lesson Policies

- Effective as of the 2011 Nov/Dec Session, any monetary credit on your account from group or private lessons shall expire one (1) year after the payment is made.
- Any monetary credit left over from payments made prior to the start of the Nov/Dec 2011 session shall expire Nov. 1, 2012.
- There is a \$5 charge for any cancellations or schedule changes made less than 2 hours before your class time. Failure to cancel or show up for class will result in the full class price being charged. Cancellation fees can only be waived with a signed doctor's note indicating the date and reason for absence.
- Parents are asked to leave pool deck once lessons start, to enable children to focus during classes.
- Please note that instructors may miss class due to illness or other reasons. When this occurs, the instructor will be replaced with another instructor (either male or female). As a result, instructors are not 100% guaranteed. Refunds will not be given due to the gender of a substitute instructor.
- There will be a \$25 charge for all refunds.
- Children not potty trained are required to wear a tight fitting swim diaper, rubber pants, and swimsuit in the pool.

DuPage Swimming Center Waiver and Assumption of Risk:

Important Information

The DuPage Swimming Center is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and holds the safety of participants in high regard. The DuPage Swimming Center continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions that are designed to protect the participant's safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for group swimming lessons must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities/programs.

You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward is/are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

Warning of Risk

Recreational activities/programs are intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any recreational activity/program. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. As such, participants must understand that certain risks, dangers and injuries due to slipping, falling, poor skill level or conditioning, carelessness, horseplay, unsportsmanlike conduct, premises defects, inadequate or defective equipment, and all other circumstances, inherent to indoor swimming activities/programs exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the DuPage Swimming Center to guarantee absolute safety.

Waiver and Release of All Claims

Please read this form carefully and be aware that in signing up and participating in private swimming lessons, you will be expressly assuming the risk and legal liability and waiving and releasing all claims for injuries, damages or loss which you or your minor child/ward might sustain as a result of participating in any and all activities connected with and associated with said programs/activities.

I recognize and acknowledge that there are certain risks of physical injury to participants in these programs/activities, and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of any and all injuries, damages or loss, regardless of severity that my minor child/ward or I may sustain as a result of said participation. I further agree to waive and relinquish all claims I or my minor child/ward may have (or accrue to me or my child/ward) as a result of participating in these programs/activities against the DuPage Swimming Center, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees.

I do hereby fully release and forever discharge the DuPage Swimming Center, including its officials, agents, volunteers and employees from any and all claims for injuries, damages, or loss that my minor child/ward or I may have or which may accrue to me or my minor child/ward and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with these programs/activities. This release shall be binding upon me and my heirs, legal representatives, and assigns.

I have read and fully understand the above important information, warning of risk, assumption of risk and waiver and release of all claims.

Winter 2012 Registration Procedures

Registrations will not be accepted over the phone.

- EVERYONE must fill out a paper Registration Form for EACH SESSION. You will not automatically be signed up for the next session.

- EVERYONE must sign the waiver on the back of the Registration Form.

- All past due amounts on accounts must be PAID IN FULL before your registration form can be processed.

- If you are unsure if you have any past due amounts please ask our Front Desk Staff for assistance.

- Schedules will be processed in the order received. No one may hand in Registration Forms prior to his/her assigned Registration Date (no exceptions).

PAYMENT MUST BE INCLUDED AT TIME OF REGISTRATION.

- If you turn in a form without payment it will not be processed.

- After your Registration Form is processed you will receive a call to confirm you child's schedule (day of week, time, and level). You will now be emailed your child's schedule. As such, please make sure that your email is clearly printed on your registration form. If you do not receive an email, please contact us by phone. Please check your lesson schedule for accuracy.
